

New Zealand Census of Population and Dwellings Tuesday, 5 March 2013

The census is the official count of how many people and dwellings there are in New Zealand. By law everyone in New Zealand on census day must fill in a census form.

Completing your forms online is secure, quick and easy. You have the option of completing English or Māori forms either online, or on paper.

If everyone in your household completes their forms online, a collector may not need to call back. Thank you for your time and effort.

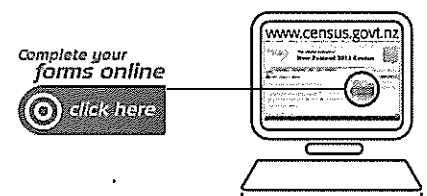

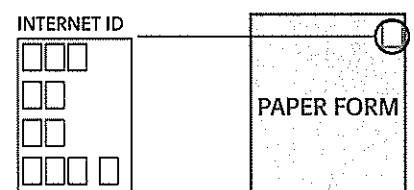
How to complete your census forms online

- 1 To complete your forms online you will need:
 - your Internet ID from your paper forms
 - the secure Internet Access Code printed below.

- 2 Go to www.census.govt.nz and click on:
'Complete your forms online'.



- 3 Enter your **Internet ID** from your paper forms.
Your Internet ID is in the top right-hand corner of the paper forms delivered to your address.



- 4 Enter your **Internet Access Code** and follow the instructions.
This secure code is unique to this household. Keep this code safe until each member of your household has used it to complete their forms.

- 5 You can now complete your census forms online.
Once you have submitted your forms the detail cannot be viewed again by you or anyone in your household.
Remember to **logout** when you are finished.
